- A qualified teacher is a teacher that holds a recognised British qualification to teach. (Currently employed as such for one term or more.) 3
-
- A newly qualified teacher, (NQT) is a teacher currently teaching on a provisional basis and has not completed the NQT induction (Currently employed as such for one term or more.) 4
-
- An overseas teacher is a teacher, who may or may not hold an overseas teaching qualification. and is required to complete the Overseas Trained Teacher Programme and has not completed that programme.. 5

- An unqualified teacher is a teacher that does not hold a recognised British qualification to teach. including overseas teachers. (Currently employed as such for one term or more.) 6
